


OUR PRIORITIES ARE TO...

Campaign for increased budgets (capital and staffing) for the pedestrian environment by the City of Edinburgh Council, especially to:

- widen footways;
- tackle pavement clutter;
- improve priority for pedestrians at signalled crossings;
- improve accessibility by installing dropped kerbs and continuous footways.
- Influence CEC to better control parking (including new 'pavement parking' provisions) and speeding.
- > Support local campaigns for place-making and traffic reduction.
- > Make school streets safer.
- Influence CEC planning policy and practice to support walking and wheeling and reduce motor traffic.
